The monument known as Island I Vow, castle and settlement, Loch Lomond, comprises the remains of a 16<sup>th</sup>-century castle and small rectangular buildings, enclosure walls and a jetty which are contemporaneous with the castle. The area to be scheduled comprises Island I Vow which measures a maximum 98m N to S by 80m E to W. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Arrochar and the County of Dumbarton as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Scheduled Area



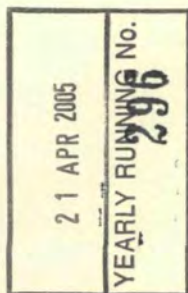
