for any interest they may have as owners or otherwise of the Monument known as Duntarvie Castle contained within an area of ground extending to 220 square yards or thereby and measuring 90 feet on each of its north and south sides and 22 feet on each of its east and west sides, the south eastmost corner of said area being situated 90 yards north west by west of the north west corner of the westmost block of farm buildings at Old Duntarvie, 80 yards north west of the road running north from Winchburgh past Old Duntarvie at its nearest point and 200 yards west south west by south of the junction of the east side of said road with the south side of the road running west from Trolleywells,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands of Duntarvie, part of the Lordship and Barony of Hopetoun,

situated in the Parish of Abercorn and
County of West Lothian.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
