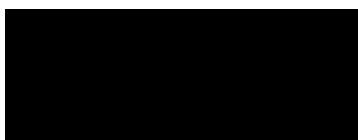

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Old Dundas Castle, castle, sundial and dovecot, dated 25 September and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of West Lothian on 14 October both in the year 1935 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as being 1. A square measuring 20m N-S by 20m E-W which corresponds to the tower house. 2. A circle of 5m diameter, centred on the fountain/sundial, to include the sundial and an area around it to ensure its continued protection and 3. A circle of 20m diameter, centred on the dovecot, to include the dovecot and an area around it to ensure its continued protection as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.
