The monument known as Teampull na Trionaid and Teampull Clann a'Phiocair, church, North Uist, comprises the remains of Teampull na Trionaid (Church of the Holy Trinity), the building known as Teampull Clann a'Phiocair (Chapel of the MacVicars), associated structures and graveyard at Carinish, North Uist. The area to be scheduled is irregular, extending approximately 5m in all directions beyond the outer walls of the churches and graveyards, to include the churches, graveyards and an area beyond in which associated remains may survive. Active burial lairs, visible gravemarkers, above-ground elements of modern field boundaries abutting the site and existing field drains are excluded from the scheduling, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of North Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

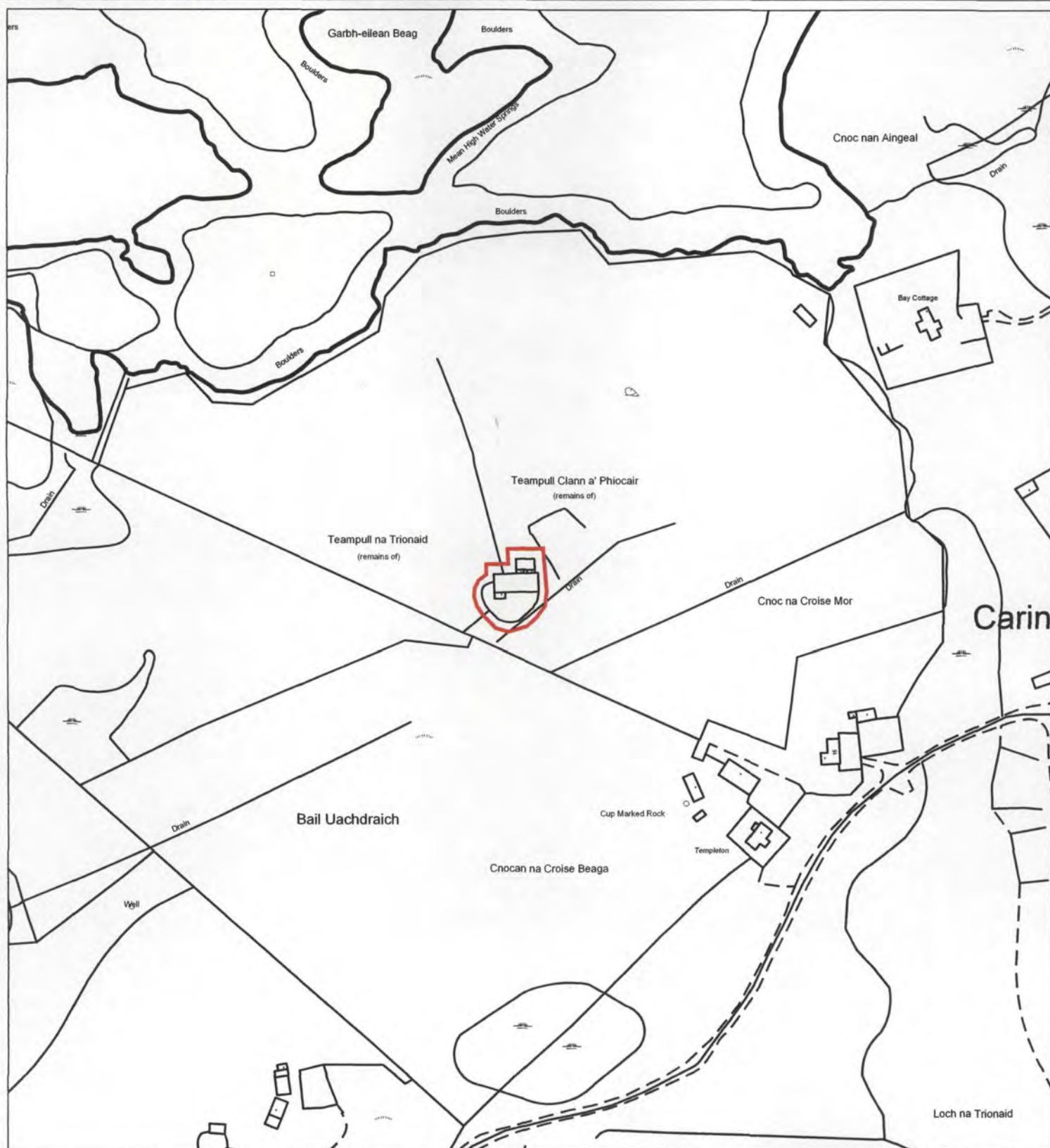

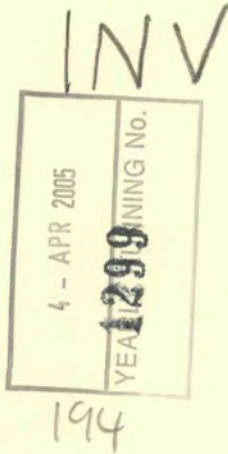
