

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Island Muller Castle comprises the fragmentary remains of a small tower house standing upon the summit of Island Muller, a small rock promontory which projects into the mouth of the Kilbrannon Sound. On the promontory there are also the remains of associated buildings. The area to be scheduled includes Island Muller, with its causeway to the mean high water level, the tower house and the associated buildings and structures. The area is irregular in shape and has maximum dimensions of about 150m NW-SE and about 87m NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Campbeltown and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto


