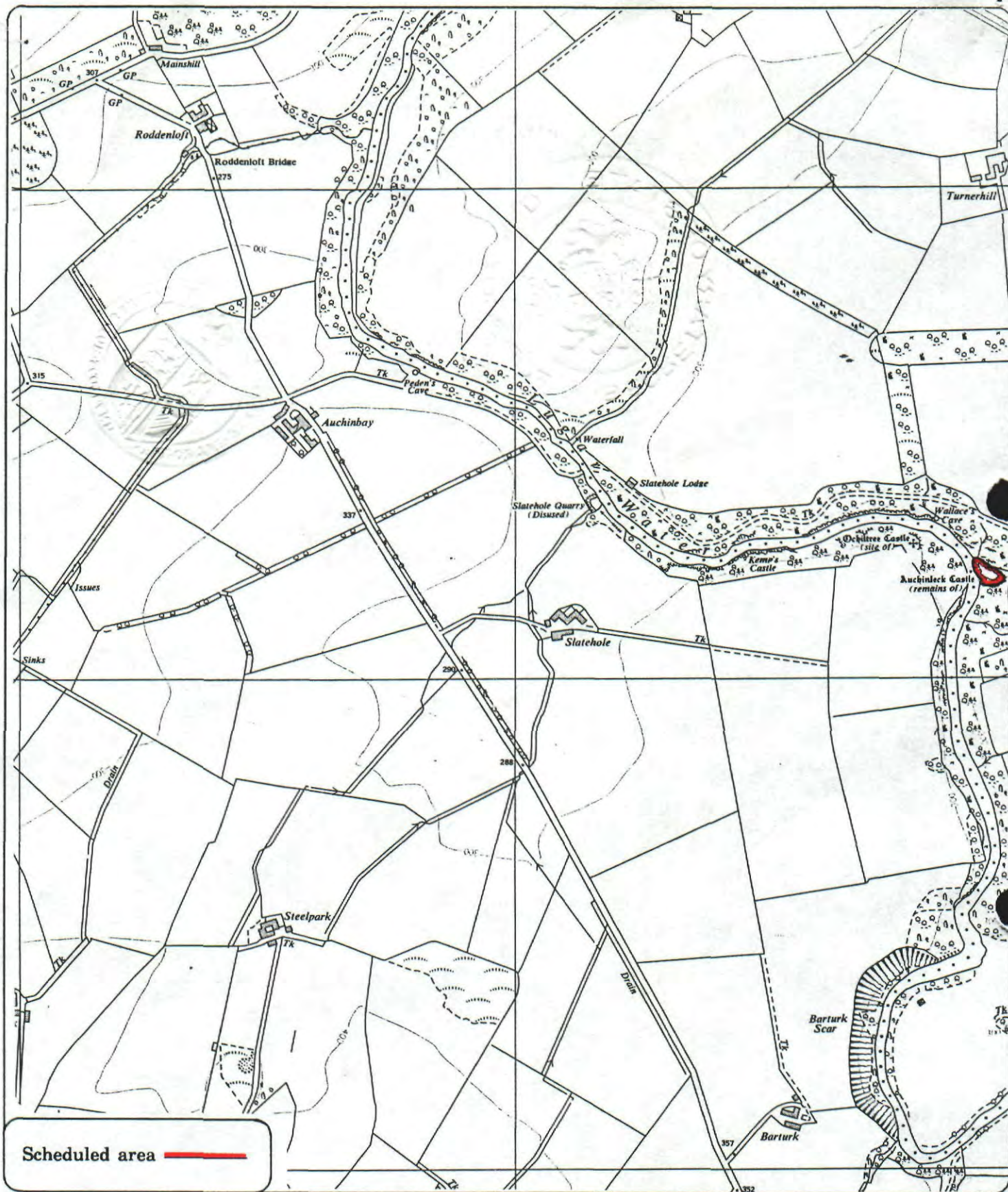

Scheduled area —

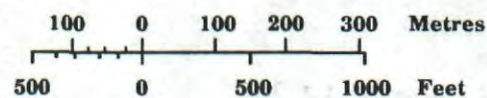
